Definitions

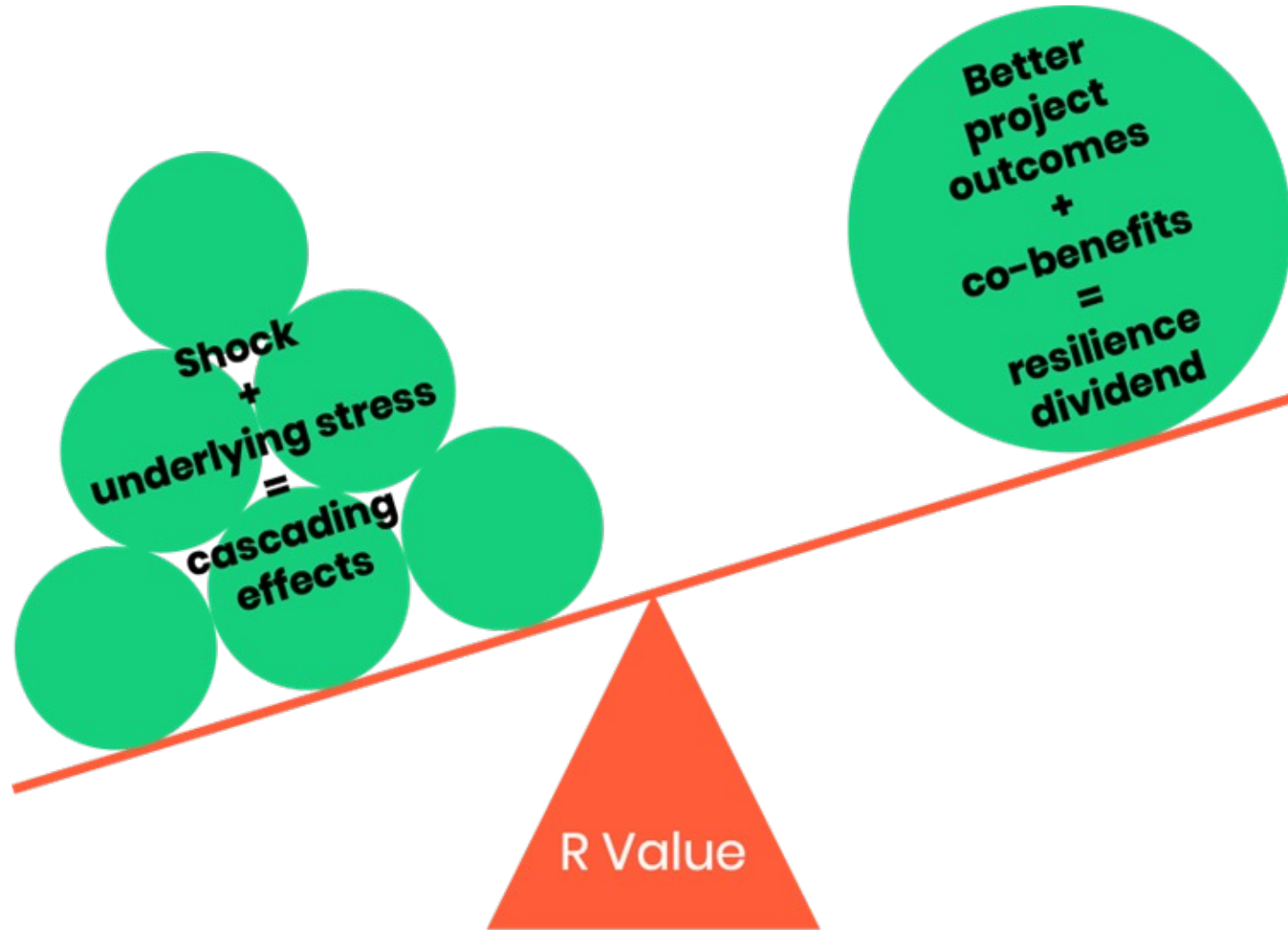
- **Resilience:** the capacity of individuals, communities, institutions, businesses, and systems to survive, adapt, and **THRIVE** no matter what kinds of chronic stresses and acute shocks they experience.
- **Acute Shock:** sudden, sharp events that harm individuals, buildings, businesses, organizations, natural ecosystems and weaken the fabric of a community or larger human or nature-based system.
- **Chronic Stress:** slow moving, existing impacts that burden individuals, buildings, businesses, organizations, natural ecosystems and weaken the fabric of a community or nature-based system on a day-today or cyclical basis.

Importantly, shocks and stresses are overlapping and interconnected, and the intersection of shocks and stresses often creates cascading effects, potentially leading to additional shocks and stresses. Climate change is a **stress**, but it is an overarching one, exacerbating existing stresses and colliding shocks.

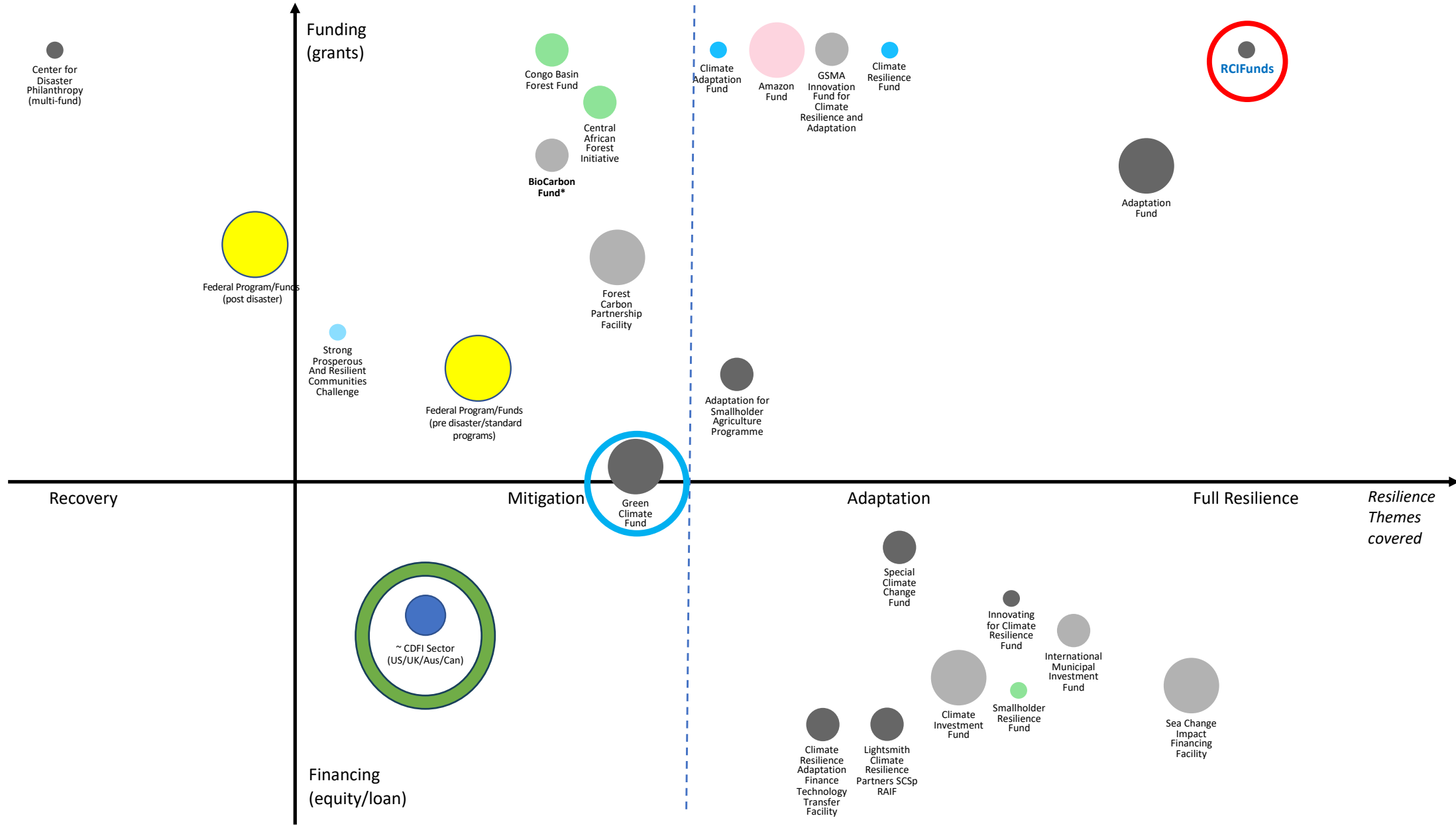
Conditions today

Financing Spectrum 2023-2024

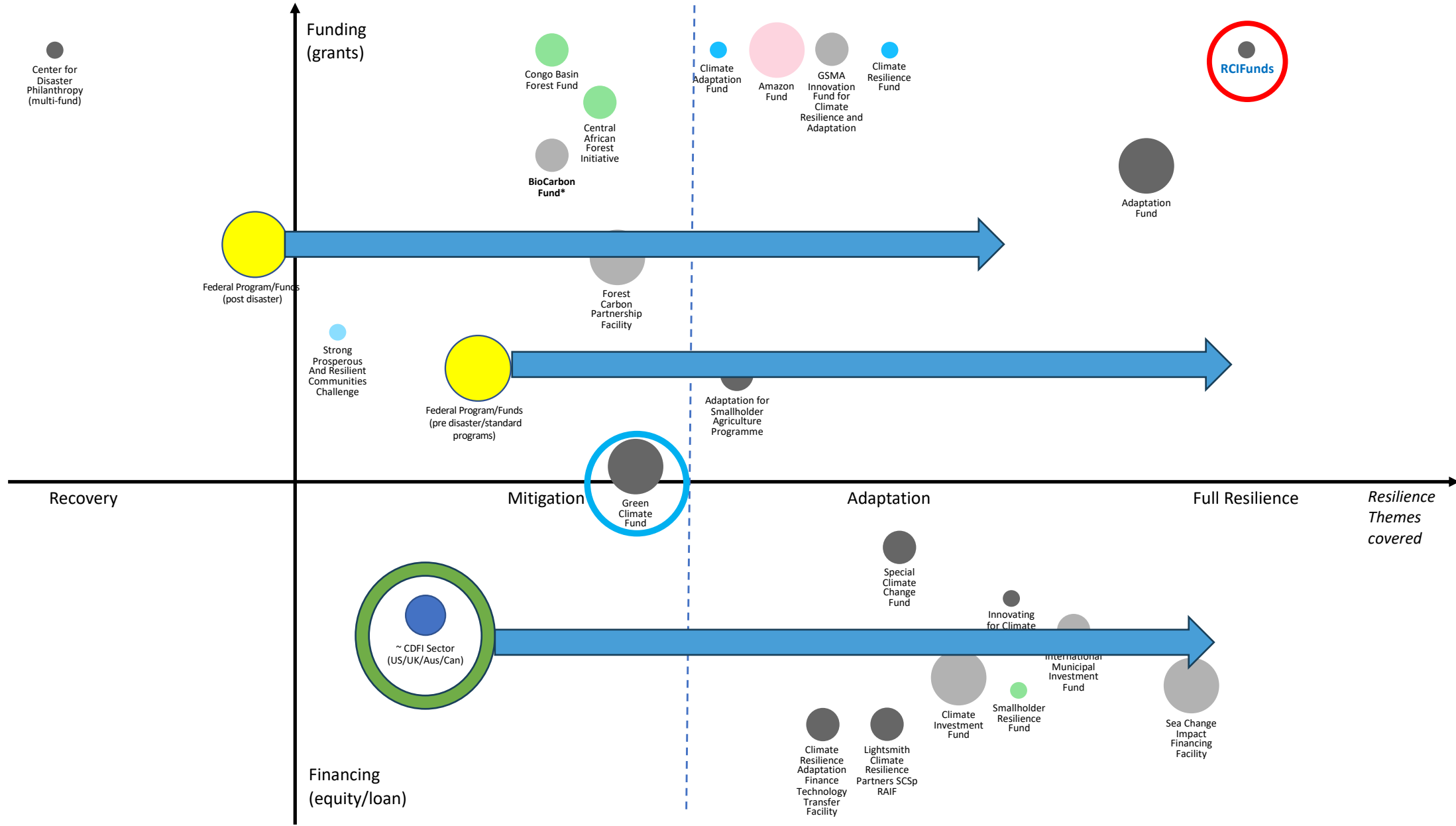

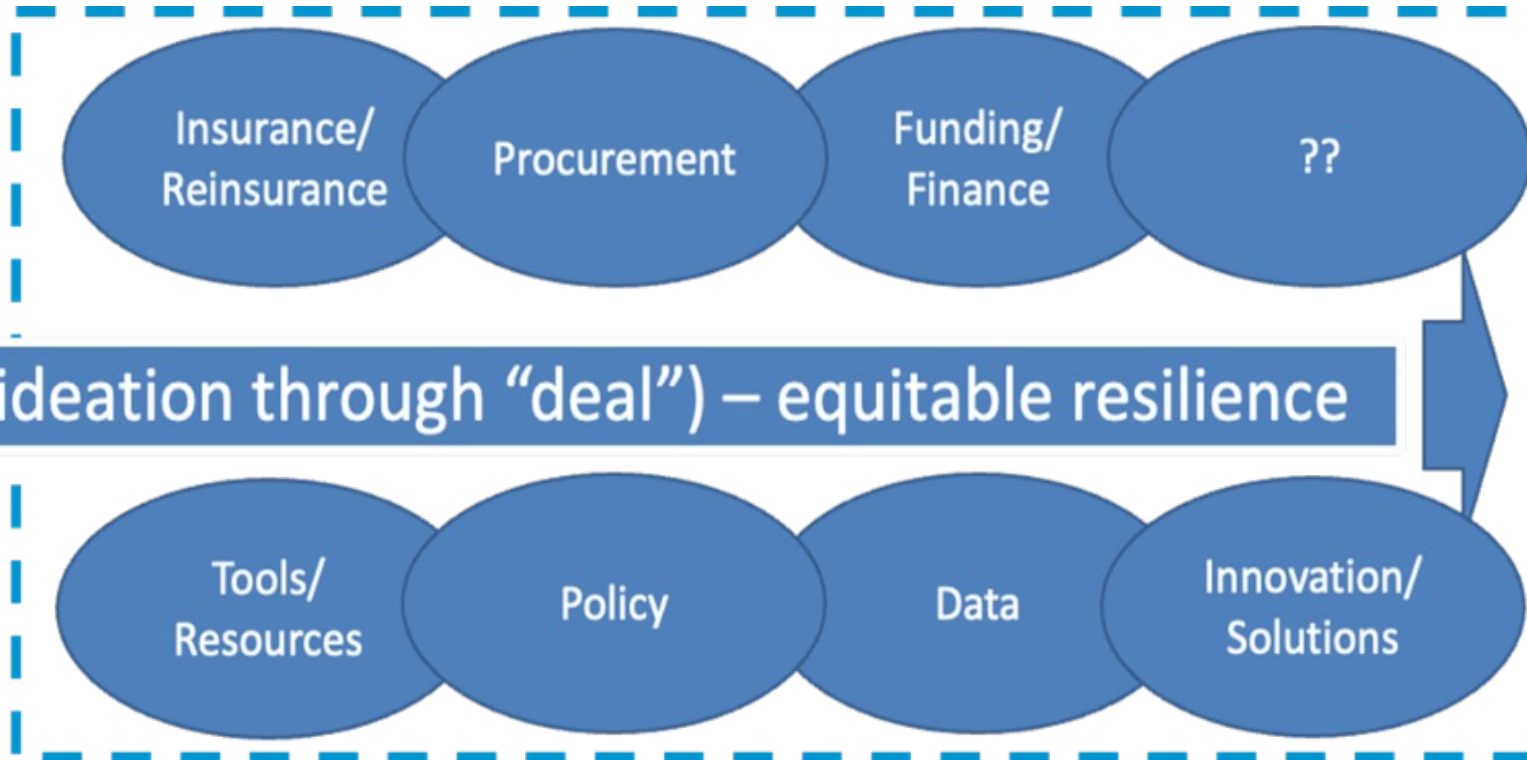
